The Town of Clitherall board of Supervisors meet in Battle Lake on Wednesday, March 9, 2022, as a Canvass Board for the local 2022 elections.


The meeting was called to order by Chairman Craig Bengtson at 9:05 pm. Those also present were Treasurer Linda Nelson, Supervisor Keith Baldwin, Supervisor Kevin Anderson, and Deputy Clerk Deb Biederman.

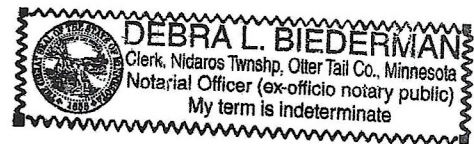
Deputy Clerk Biederman gave the Oath to the three (3) Supervisor's. She presented the board with an abstract, known as a summary statement, from the towns appointed Election Judges along with write-in material.

Once the Canvass Board examined the material given to them and they were certain satisfied with the election results, they preceded to sign the Result of Canvass Report and the abstracts from the election judges.

With the signatures complete, the Canvass Board has declared Craig Bengtson as a township supervisor and Becky Cox as the Clerk. Becky Cox was notified that she had received write-in votes for the office of Clerk along with three (3) other township residents, but she had the highest number of votes.. She stated that she would be interested in fulfilling that position. The seven-day contest period has started.




Following the Canvass Meeting:
