Board approved the agenda.

Clerk Report. Mail and correspondence presented. Township to inform Mr. Bradley Sportel about situation of cul-de-sac on Quartz road.

Treasures Report. Grand total of all accounts \$309,322.55

Motion to approve the March Treasurer's Report as printed. The following voted for: Anderson, Bengtson, Baldwin. Against: None. MC.

Motion to approve payment of check numbers 6733-6756 for the amount of \$69, 492.17. The following voted for: Anderson, Bengtson, Baldwin. Against: None. MC.

Motion to transfer \$75,000 from Battle Lake money market into Battle Lake checking account. The following voted for: Anderson, Bengtson, Baldwin. Against: None. MC.

Battle Lake Motor Patrol update: Motor patrol paid \$60,000 for the 2022 Caterpillar grader. New blade has arrived. Issue with a tire on the new blade which is not covered by warranty. Town board to look into Township road grading policies.

Battle Lake Fire Department update: Thursday, April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2022 will be Annual Meeting at 7pm at the Fire Hall. Five new hires for fire department. Start date set for May 1st.

Road Inspection Update: Bengtson spoke with snowplow driver of Clitherall Township who provided map of where trees need to be trimmed. Baldwin to arrange hire to conduct tree trimming. Trefoldighed and 183<sup>rd</sup> signs down from snow plowing/pushing.

Planning and Zoning:

Building permit presented on Bonnie Beach Road to rebuild a garage.

Old Business: Veterans Park interested in laying cement pad in front of garage door. One gravel quote received, from Earl Strande Excavating.

Motion to accept gravel quote from Earl Strande Excavating. The following voted for: Anderson, Bengtson, Baldwin. Against: None. MC.

Second half of ARPA funding to come in sometime this summer.

New Business: Reviewed chloride rate.

Motion to increase chloride reimbursement to 40 cents per foot. The following voted for: Anderson, Bengtson, Baldwin. Against: None. MC.

Board to set up meeting with Nidaros Township to discuss town line agreement and chloride issue.

Anderson Brothers Construction needs to apply for variance prior to starting temporary crushing plant project and another public hearing will need to be held. Planning Commission to hold a public hearing Thursday, May 12<sup>th</sup> at 6:00pm contingent upon receiving variance request.

Under advice of council will not discuss Lakes & Woods Storage at this time.

Open Forum for Public Comment: Fence ordinance discussed. Vote still set for Wednesday June 8<sup>th</sup>.

Motion to approve March monthly meeting as printed.

Board approved minutes as printed.
