Regular Monthly Meeting
June 9th, 2021

Craig Bengtson called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. The following members were present: Craig Bengtson, Linda Nelson, Keith Baldwin, Jaden Witt. Several community members present. Pledge of Allegiance was said by all.

Board approved the agenda.

Clerk Report. Mail/correspondence presented. Request to update approach permit to include the cost of application fee and deposit.

Board approved request to update approach permit.

Treasures Report. Grand total of all accounts \$613,415.51

Motion to approve the May Treasurer's Report as printed. The following voted for: Anderson, Bengtson, Baldwin. Against: None. MC.

Board approved transferring \$100,000 from First National Bank Battle Lake general fund to Farmers State Bank Underwood Money Market.

Motion to approve payment of check numbers 6486-6500 for the amount of \$114,396.30 (\$100,000 of which was transferring from the general fund to the money market as approved above). The following voted for: Anderson, Bengtson, Baldwin. Against: None. MC.

Planning Commission Meeting date set for Monday July 19th at the Motor Patrol Building at 7:00PM.

Battle Lake Motor Patrol update: John Deere grader tested. Annual meeting at 6:00PM at Motor Patrol Building Monday June 14th.

Battle Lake Fire Department update: Increase in calls. Rescue rig waiting new equipment.

Road Inspection Update:

Planning and Zoning: One building permit presented.

Approach permit: community member posed question about adding an approach. Board discussed and provided information.

Road Improvement Projects: Elmdale/Country Estates update on tree removal. Approval from land owner to remove some trees but not all. Beaver dig spots fixed on Antler Trail. Gravel in ditch on Antler Trail bothersome to land owner nearby. Country Estates has high gravel spots from filling, did not settle. Stakes will be placed on South Clitherall Lake Road to map out plan for road work.

Old Business: Clitherall Township was not awarded the Local Road Improvement Grant. Crack filling and seal coating underway. Tree trimming projects continuing. Gravel still needs to be crushed and added before chloride can be applied. Veterans Park lawn was seeded. Letters for the building sign arrived and need to be put up. Jeff Stabnow donating cost for Sign Works to put up letters for building sign. Nelson to speak with County to get update on County Shoreline Ordinance.

New Business: Will be spraying weeds soon. Clitherall Township may be eligible for American Rescue Act Funds.
